
Weeds of Sweetwater Creek - Recognition and Treatment.

Cape Ivy (Delairea odorata): origin South Africa

Description: Ivy—like leaves, light green and fleshy with pointed tips. Bright yellow daisy-like flowers in winter and spring.



Habit: Climbs bushes and trees, smothering their growth; spreads via creepers and seeds.

Treatment: Remove small plants first and bag. Larger plants need to be cut near the ground and painted with a weed-dabber (Roundup). Detach creepers from trees where possible, without damaging trees, and bag. Rake up remnants afterwards and bag. Best dealt with before flowering and setting seed.
